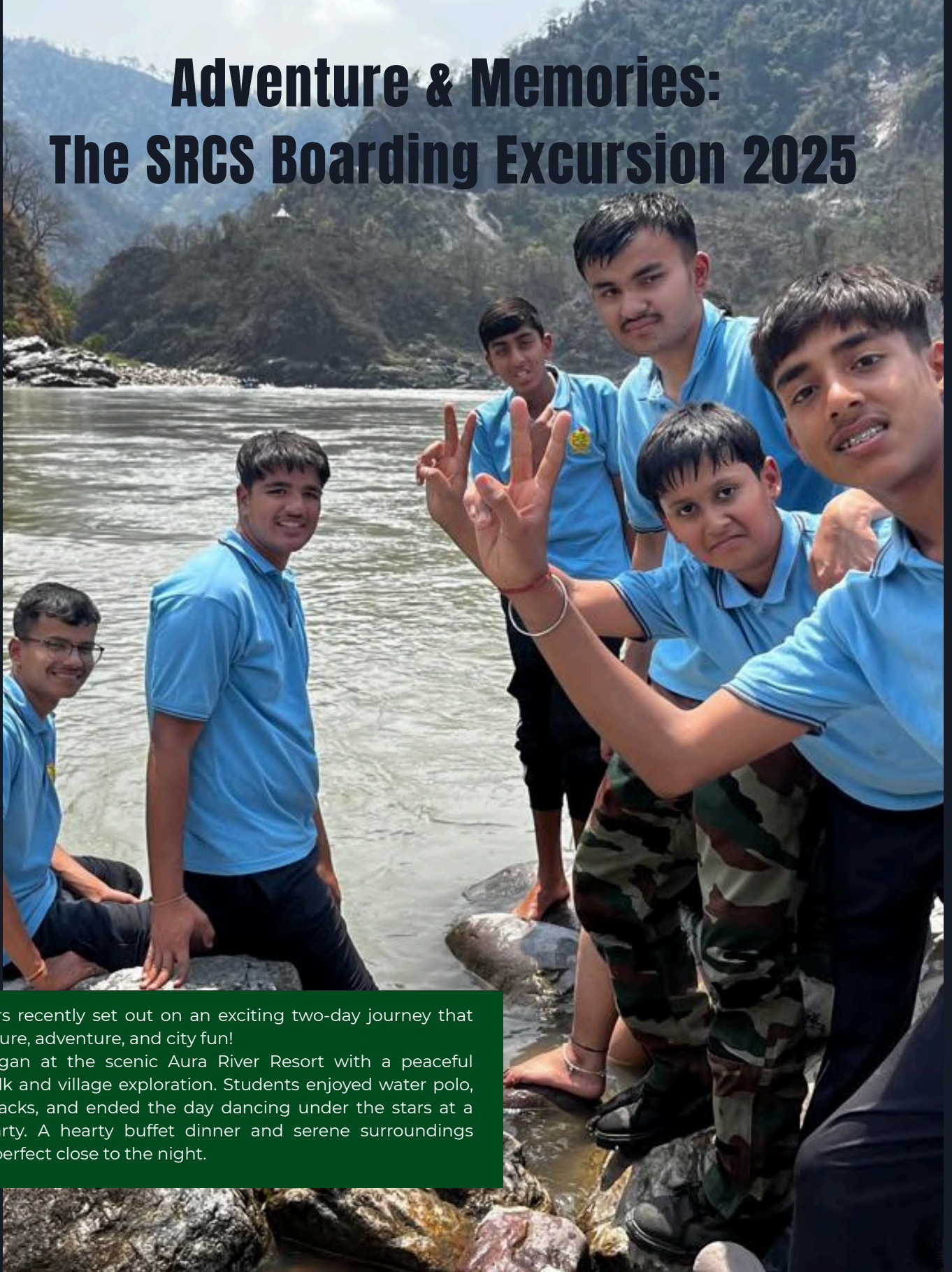

अभिभावक उन्मुखीकरण कार्यक्रम- २०२५

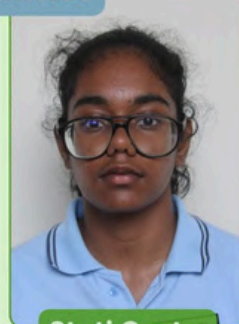
